Pre-arrival Information

Spring Semester 2022

This pre-arrival information includes crucial information that will help you prepare your departure for Ajou!

■ Applying for Student Visa (D-2-6)

All international exchange students are required to obtain D-2-6 (exchange) visa for their study at Ajou. In order to obtain a D-2-6 visa, you must submit the required documents to the Korean Embassy or Consulate in your country.

These documents have been sent to your home university or to the confirmed address via post.

- (1) Certificate of Admission
- (2) Invitation Letter
- (3) Certificate of Business Registration of Ajou University

The application procedure and required documents may vary depending on the embassy or consulate, so it is advised that you check with your local Korean embassy or consulate beforehand. Please note that you need to sign the Certificate of Admission issued by Ajou University before submitting it to the embassy.

If you have already obtained another type of visa, you **must** change it to **D-2-6**. The duration of the visa is determined by the Korean consular officer, and the expiration date on your visa may not match the end date of your program. If your visa expires before you complete your tasks, you will need to apply for a visa extension at the Korean Immigration Office.

Required documents may be added or changed depending on individual circumstances. For more information, please visit the Korean immigration website – Hi Korea (E-Government for Foreigners) at www.hikorea.go.kr.

■ Health and Medical Clearance Form

All students have been requested to submit the health and medical clearance form with their online application as part of the required documents. However, if it is not submitted upon application, students will need to get re-tested for tuberculosis at the district public health center in Korea upon arrival. Please note that the OIA will submit your tuberculosis test result to the Office of Student Housing & Residence at Ajou University **at once** so individual submission will not be necessary. Furthermore, please note that according to the government regulation, students from certain designated countries, listed below, are required to submit TB test result upon their D-2-6 *visa application*.

The designated 19 countries are: *Cambodia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Mongolia, Indonesia, India, Nepal, Vietnam, Thailand, Russia, Malaysia, Uzbekistan, China, Sri Lanka, East Timor, Kyrgyzstan, Laos*

■ Dormitory Application

The application will be available online at Ajou website:

The application period is from **January 15th ~ February 2nd, 2022** and you will need to input the following for a successful application:

- 1) Your registered email address
- 2) Ajou student ID number as the *application ID*

You can find the registered email address and student ID number on the Letter of Invitation.

International Dorm: Jan 15th – Jan 18th

Hwahong Hall(2-person bedroom): Jan 22nd – Jan 25th

Hwahong Hall(4-person bedroom): Jan 29th – Feb 2nd

Please note that housing applications after the application period will not be accepted, and, unfortunately, we cannot guarantee your placement. After the successful completion of your housing registration, your room will be assigned accordingly. Students cannot choose roommates and it will be randomly assigned by the Office of Residence.

University dormitory will open on the designated dates for new coming students for the Spring semester 2022 so please set your flight schedule to arrive accordingly.

■ Course Registration

Course registration will be available online from **February 17-18th, 2022**. The tentative course list will be announced on our website and the **final list** will be uploaded in **around the last week of January or first week of February** before the official course registration.

Meanwhile, you may refer to the course list offered in the **Spring and Fall semester** on our website as similar courses are offered on each corresponding semester.

* The above schedule is subject to change and will be announced via email.

Please note that you can **add and drop** courses during the course changing period. Also, we would like to inform you that you can **only withdraw from one course** during the course withdrawal period, so please avoid registering irrelevant courses during the course registration. For online course registration during the mandatory quarantine, make sure to bring your laptop.

■ Orientation

All international students are required to attend the orientation. The orientation will assist you with any questions you may have during your stay at Ajou University.

The orientation will include important information such as the academic schedule, alien registration, health insurance and tips for living in Korea will be introduced to prepare you for your life in Korea. Online meeting link will be announced shortly via individual's email.

■ Health Insurance Policy at Ajou

All incoming exchange & visiting students studying at Ajou University are obligated to obtain personal health insurance as a condition of admission. Students must purchase an insurance for the full study period, including periods of travel before and after their exchange period at Ajou University.

From 1st of March 2021, holders of Study (D-2) visa are subject to the statutory subscription to the National Health Insurance Service (NHIS) in accordance with the Korean Government's regulation. It is mandatory for international students. The aforementioned visa holders will be automatically subscribed to the NHIS. The subscription information will be mailed to the address written in the Alien Registration Card. If insurance fees are unpaid, the insurance benefits will be limited and disadvantages when staying in Korea such as visa extension and etc. may arise.

If a student receives medical coverage equivalent to medical care benefits by foreign laws or from foreign insurance can apply for exemption from the subscription. The application for exemption can be rejected by the NHIS.

■ Meals & Food

Students can buy various types of meals on and off-campus, and also cook some instant snacks in the shared kitchen of the dormitory. Students usually use the kitchen to cook noodles, toast, and small snacks or to keep their own food in the communal refrigerator. Normal meal prices range from 5,000 won to 7,000 won (approx. USD 5 ~ 7) per meal on campus.

■ Alien Registration

Foreigners staying in Korea for more than 90 days must register for the alien registration at a local immigration office within 90 days from the date of entry. Simply receiving your visa is not the last step to registration, and those with visas must receive an ARC (Alien registration card) to finalize their sojourn documentation. **It is illegal to stay in Korea for more than 90 days without being registered, regardless of your visa at entry.**

The required documents for your ARC application is as below:

- 1) Application Form
- 2) Copy of Passport
- 3) Copy of Visa Page
- 4) 1 color face photo (3.5 * 4.5, passport photo regulations apply)
- 5) Certificate of Enrollment at Ajou
- 6) Certificate of Residence (issued by the dormitory coordinator)
- 7) Application fee: KRW 30,000

Note: The incoming coordinator will collect your documents and submit them to the Suwon Immigration Office at once. Once the applications are submitted, students will need to visit the Immigration Office with the coordinator to register their fingerprints. It usually takes about 3~5 weeks for the immigration office to process the issuance of your ARC application.

■ Student ID card

Student ID card can be issued ONLY when you make your own Ajou Portal ID. Your student ID Card will be distributed from the Office of Residence or Office of International Affairs upon your arrival.

■ To open a bankaccount

If you would like to open a bank account in Korea, you will need the Alien Registration card and your passport.

■ Information associated with COVID-19

While Staying in Korea, If you are classified as a close contact of a person that tests positive for COVID-19 and asked to be quarantined, you cannot stay in dormitory and will need to move to external facility on your own expenses(Accommodation, Meals, Transportation, etc.)

If you do not move in without paying by the due date without any notice, your application will be cancelled.

** Please check that you can be arranged in a 2-bed room even though you apply for the 4-bed room due to the lack of 4 bed-rooms.

4. Submission of Health Check-up result

Before moving in to the dorm, all residents should submit the result of the health check-up (especially for tuberculosis result).

The result sheet must show normal or abnormal of TB in English or Korean. Without the result sheet, students cannot move in.

The Office of International Affairs will forward the TB test results to the Office of Student Housing & Residence at once.

❖ If you didn't submit the health check-up result yet, please email it to the OIA as soon as possible.

- a) If residents need to leave during the middle of the semester, residents should apply for refund request. Without refund request, the Office of Student Housing & Residence has no responsibility to refund your dorm fee.
- b) The dormitory fee will be refunded to the student according to the refund policy.
- c) The criteria of refund policy are based on the move-in date given by the dormitory and not by the individual students' actual move-in date.
 - d) Residents who are expelled due to violation of dormitory rules and regulations will receive **NO REFUND**
- e) Summer or winter vacation residents have NO REFUND even though early withdrawal from the dormitory.

6. Important Notice

- A. Due to limited accommodations, room arrangement *cannot be guaranteed as your preference* and your room can be changed even though it was assigned.
- B. If you do not apply for the dormitory within the application period, the application cannot be acceptable.
- C. If you don't pay the bill by the due date, your application will be cancelled without further notice.
- D. Every resident should *submit the TB test result* (Tuberculosis) and PCR Test result (taken within 48 hours) which states "Negative" before moving in. The OIA will submit the Exchange Students' documents at once to dormitory.
- E. If you leave your stuff in a room without applying for the dormitory, it will be cleared out. You are responsible for your own belongings, nobody can be responsible for them.
- F. Dormitory offers bedding sets (a temporary pillow, blanket and bed sheet) for only international students from the inspector office in each dorm 1st floor.
- G. Please note the move out day, and remember to leave the dorm accordingly. If you move in earlier or stay after the move-out date, you have to pay a fine (5 times the one-day fee, KRW 50,000~80,000)

Requirement for International Students

1. Eligibility to Move In

- A. Incoming international students
- B. Registered international students
 - 1) Excluding those who were on academic probation in the previous semester
 - 2) Excluding those who were given 30 points' penalties and expelled from the dormitory
 - 3) Excluding research students

2. Selection Criteria

- A. The resident selection shall take place every semester.
- B. Incoming students will be given priority.
- C. Selection criteria for currently registered students
 - 1) Currently registered students will be selected after the spots for incoming students are filled.
 - 2) The same selection criteria will be applied to currently registered students as follows. (GPA: 60 percent; basic points: 30 percent; service points: 10 percent)
 - 3) If multiple students with same GPA's and credits compete for one vacancy, the date of birth (the youngest person will be given priority) will be taken into consideration.
 - 4) Currently registered students must move out of their rooms prior to the beginning of the semester if not selected. Unless selected students make full payment by the deadline, the vacancies will be given to those next in line on the waiting list.

3. Room Assignment Guidelines

- A. Room assignment will be handled by the Office of Student Housing & Residence with full consideration of applicants' requests.
- B. The request period for room changes will be the first week of each semester. No change is allowed after this period.
- C. Students who have sleep disorders (snoring, teeth grinding, etc.) serious enough to disturb roommates cannot be accepted. You have no rights to stay alone. If you stay alone due to having sleep disorders, please pay extra the dormitory fee for other roommates, but it cannot be accepted when we do not have the remaining rooms.
- D. Students can choose from the two types of rooms: two-bed rooms and four-bed rooms. However, if there aren't any remaining rooms, the Office of Student Housing & Residence will randomly assign the rooms. If there is a lack of 4-bed room, the Office of Student Housing & Residence will arrange a 2-bed room.
- E. As for registered students, rooms will be allocated in accordance with GPA.
- F. Students will be categorized into groups of Undergraduate, Graduate School, Exchange Student, etc. when allocating the rooms.

4. Dormitory Application Procedures

- A. The dormitory application submission period for international students will be the same as local students.
- B. No application allowed after the deadline.

Housing Agreement

All residents should abide by the rules and regulations of the Ajou University Dormitory. We are maintained for students of all nations, races, and beliefs. These rules and regulations have been set for the purpose of promoting the convenience, security, and welfare of the residents of our dormitory, and to protect the dormitory's property from misuse and abuse. You are expected to be willing to follow the dormitory regulations and to be submissive to the school authorities (dormitory staff members) and their instructions, so there will be minimum of disturbances and inappropriate behaviors.

Any violations against the rules and regulations will result in penalties as follows.
