Dear student, please note that you need a Letter of Acceptance from us for the Ernst Mach application. After applying for the Ernst Mach scholarship, you also need to apply to the FH Salzburg as an exchange student (Incomig Application).

***Document package 1:**

- a letter of Motivation
- a provisional Learning Agreement/list of courses the student would like to take
- last 2 transcript of records
- a CV
- Bachelor certificate (if available)
- if available, valid English proficiency test / letter of recommendation for English skills (if mother tongue is not English)
- High School Diploma/A-Levels Certificate
- **Please note:** Exchange students interested in the degree programmes "Design & Product Management" or "MultiMediaArt" must **additionally submit a portfolio!**

**** Document package 2:**

- Two letters of recommendation by university lecturers (they must contain the letterhead, date and signature of the person recommending the applicant and the stamp of the university / department and must not be older than six months at the time of application)
- Confirmation of the home university that the exams passed in Austria will be recognized by the home university (e.g. a learning agreement)/(with stamp of the university and signature)
- Confirmation of Acceptance/Letter of Acceptance (from FH Salzburg)
- Scan of passport (page with the name and photo)
- Scan of a current Transcript of Records with logo of the home institution to prove that it is official
